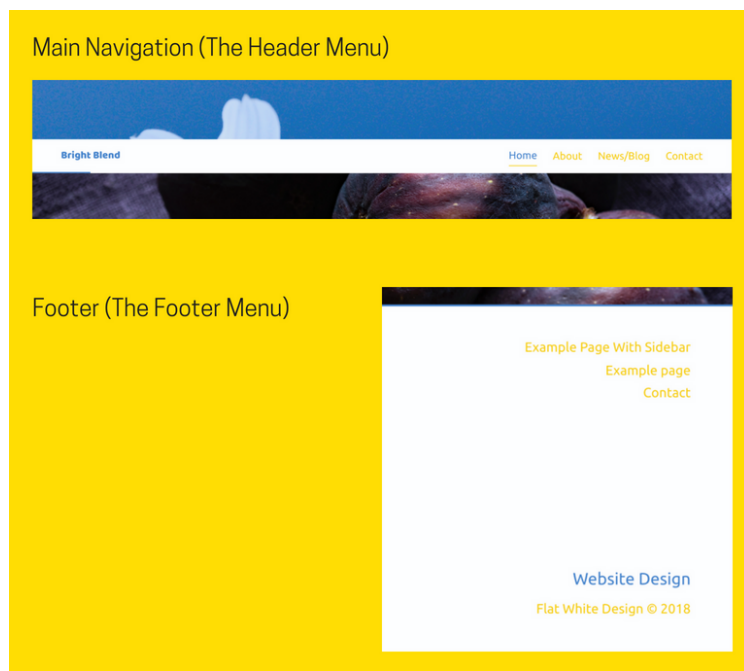


“How To....” Guide for your Flat White Website



Edit the Navigation/Menu

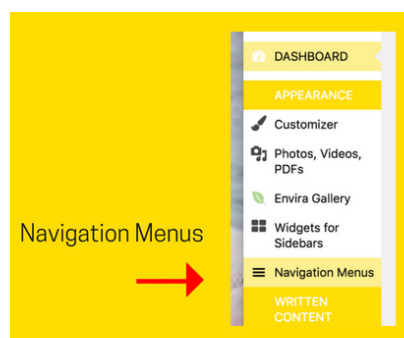
The Navigation, or Menu, is the list of pages that the visitor can access on your website. We have included two built-in menus for your Flat White Website: the Main Navigation, which sticks to the top of your page as the visitor scrolls down, and the Footer Navigation, which is at the bottom of all pages:



If you add any new pages to your website, you will need to add them to one or both menus before they will be displayed.

Editing the Menu

It is also possible to edit the Menus within the Customizer, but we recommend doing it via the WordPress Dashboard:




Adding Pages

You can add pages to either of the Menus. First, select the Menu you wish to edit – The Main Navigation, or the Footer Navigation. Click Select, and you will see the pages listed for this menu. Tick the box next to any of the pages you want to add to the selected menu, then click “Add to Menu”.

Select the Menu you want to edit, then click "Select":

Tick any pages you want to add to the selected menu:

Click "Save Menu" when you have added or removed pages



When you have made all your changes, click “Save Menu”.


Removing and Changing the Order of Pages

You can remove any pages in your menus, or change the order that the pages are displayed on your website. Click on the arrow at the right of the box of the relevant page name, and you will see a number of options displayed:

You can simplify the page name here

To remove a page from the Menu, click on the arrow next to Page

You can change the order of the menu items



You can also move the pages with drag and drop: hover your mouse over the relevant page, and then move up or down.

When you have made all your changes, click “Save Menu”.
