

# “How To....” Guide for your Flat White Website



## How to edit the Title, Tagline and Logo


This is default setting in the WordPress Customizer.

### Title and Tagline

Your website will be set up with Title that you have chosen for your website. If you want to change this, and add a Tagline, you can do this here:

Whatever you write in your Site Title will show up on your Hero Image, and in your Title Bar

Your Tagline will show up on your Hero Image - leave blank if you don't want one



### Logo



## Favicon, or Site Icon

The Favicon, or Site Icon, is the icon that shows up in a browser window to identify your website. The Flat White Websites favicon is pre-loaded in to your website. To change this, upload your own icon here. It needs to be very simple – words don't generally work, although a single letter is fine. And it needs to be at least 512px by 512px.

Site Icon

Site Icons are what you see in browser tabs, bookmark bars, and within the WordPress mobile apps. Upload one here!

Site Icons should be square and at least 512 x 512 pixels.
