## Standard Page Templates

*(Available with The Macchiato and The Flat White packages)*

When you want to add extra pages to your website, there are two templates to choose from:

### Standard Page template

This template includes the WordPress editor, where you can add text and images.

Example page

This is a Heading 3 – the best way to introduce your page to the reader.

This is paragraph text, which needs to contain the body of information on your page.

**Make use of Bold to highlight important parts of your text!** Migas cold-pressed cillum tousled, four dollar toast tote bag tumblr next level pariatur. Celiac microdosing aesthetic mustache. As well as the WordPress Editor, this template includes a Sidebar.
